We opened our doors in August 2006 and welcome students ages 16 to 18 who are not in school today. We are the only school located in northeast Toronto that is open year round. We help you earn compulsory credits for Grades 9, 10, 11, and 12. We mostly offer courses at the applied level. We are a small alternative high school that believes in social justice and opportunity for all. We are conveniently located near the Sheppard/Don Mills subway station.

2 Credits in 9 Weeks

We have a unique program that enables you to complete two credits over nine weeks. Enrolling a course for one credit in the morning; have lunch and take another credit course in theafternoon. Our dedicated teachers know you and are available to help you throughout the day with homework or review so you can complete each day's work before you leave.



Flexible Structure With Four Sessions

Everyone learns at a different pace. Our Flexible program helps you earn the credits you need to be successful. We offer you an innovative model of four learning sessions throughout the year. Instead of two semesters, each session consists of 45 days. We also offer credit recovery to students who have attempted credits unsuccessfully.
