- **TUITION FEE** is to be made payable to the **Toronto District School Board** by certified cheque, bank draft, money order in Canadian currency or through wire transfer.
- Detailed payment instruction available at www.studytoronto.ca.
- **HEALTH INSURANCE is included in the tuition fee.** Comprehensive health insurance is mandatory in Ontario and every international student must have this coverage while studying in Toronto.

REFUND POLICY FOR TUITION FEE

- A full tuition fee refund, less the administration fee (CAD\$500.00), will be granted if Citizenship and Immigration Canada does not issue the Study Permit. To obtain a refund, the student must provide:
 1. The original Letter of Rejection from Citizenship and Immigration Canada
 2. The original TDSB Official Letter of Acceptance
 3. The original receipt of tuition payment
 4. A written refund request by the parent including the name and address of the cheque recipient
- There will be no refund of the tuition fee in the following circumstances:
 - if the student chooses to withdraw for reasons other than the Study Permit has been denied by Citizenship and Immigration Canada
 - if the student is found in violation of school regulations and asked to withdraw from the school
 - if false medical information was given and conditions were not disclosed
- In the event that the student's immigration status changes during the school year, the parent of the student is to contact the International Programs and Admissions Office immediately.
