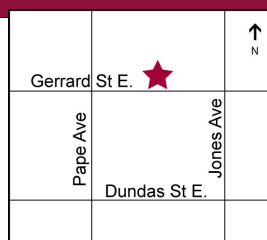

Job Search Workshop Descriptions

*Offered at 7 TDSB Locations: Don Mills, Downsview, Riverdale, Scarborough
Dundas-Dixie, Mississauga Meadowvale, and Vaughan.*

Refining Your Resume and Cover Letter Workshop Part 1: In this group workshop, learn about the different types of resumes and how to develop your own targeted resume and cover letter to for a specific position.

Refining Your Resume and Cover Letter Workshop Part 2: Put in to practice your skills from part 1. Bring your USB and get specific one-on-one advice on your resume and cover letter from the facilitator. Limited computers available, bring your laptop.

Interview Skills + Online Interviewing– This group workshop will explore strategies and skills to prepare for your next interview, internet interviewing will also be discussed.

Interview Skills for Hiring Events– This group workshop will explore the most common questions asked at hiring fairs and how to answer them. Opportunities for practice will be given.

Access Hidden Jobs: This group workshop will teach you the secrets to conducting the top two successful job search techniques: networking and cold calling with employers, friends, and strangers.

One-on-One Resume Reviews: This individual session is for those who have a resume and require some minor tweaking to enhance their resume to target specific employment opportunities. Participants must bring a current resume and job posting to this session.

One-on-One Interview Practice: Participants will individually engage in a simulated interview scenario. This session will provide participants with invaluable feedback on how to improve interview performance.

Applying for Second Career and Labour Market Information : This full day group workshop will help you to understand and fill in the training application and to research the labor market. A referral from your Employment Advisor is required to ensure you qualify.
