

Emergency Plan for Public

In the event of a LIFE-THREATENING MEDICAL EMERGENCY:

(A life-threatening medical emergency may involve: choking, non breathing, chest pain, shortness of breath, severe bleeding or trauma, or an altered level of awareness)

1. <u>Immediately call 9-1-1(if using a school phone know how to dial out)</u>

- This will initiate an Emergency Services (EMS & Fire) response
- Provide information to the Emergency Medical Dispatcher as prompted
- Notify the Dispatcher that there is an AED on site (if they do not already know)

2. Send a bystander to go get the AEDs and bring it back to the medical emergency

**Look for the Automated External Defibrillator (AED) symbol displayed at schools with AED
Defibrillators**



3. Contact Staff Member/Caretaker (use a bystander if possible)

- State that there is a medical emergency and provide location to staff
- This may be the schools on-duty caretaking staff

4. Send more than one bystander to direct various arriving emergency personnel

- Police/Fire/Ambulance will arrive at different times
- Direct bystanders to the main entrance to escort them to the emergency location
- 5. Provide care until Emergency Services (EMS) take over
