Operating Engineers (Shift Leaders) – Required

Incumbents will be responsible for the operation of steam boilers per TSSA regulations and will also work on a wide variety of assigned tasks including:

- Providing a safe, healthy and comfortable environment for all building occupants in accordance with current caretaking cleaning standards;
- Directing the work of the on-site caretaking staff during the shift;
- Performing caretaking duties – including operating heating and ventilation equipment; pool maintenance; receiving and delivering supplies; lifting; climbing; floor cleaning; mopping; moving furniture; re-lamping; lunch room program duties; grounds cleaning and maintenance including grass cutting, snow and ice removal, maintenance of grounds, garbage removal; operating heavy powered cleaning equipment; etc.
- Ensuring the safe and continuous operation of all building operating equipment in accordance with provincial/municipal statutes and Board policies and procedures;
- Maintaining appropriate records as required.

Qualifications:

- **Candidates must possess a minimum of a 4th Class Operating Engineers Certificate of Qualification**
- A good command of written and oral English and the proven ability to communicate in a sensitive, courteous and tactful manner;
- Demonstrated proficiency with Information Technology including the use of computers and related software applications;
- Minimum Grade 10 Secondary School education;
- Good attendance and punctuality;
- Ability to work with a minimum of supervision
