## Frequently Asked Questions - Registration and Program Information

### How can I register?

There are 2 ways to register. You can go to the International Languages Elementary / African Heritage school during program hours (as listed in the brochure). Also, online registration is available at [www.ileprograms.ca](http://www.ileprograms.ca).

### What do I need to register?

Please bring your child/ren's health card number, Ontario Enrolment Number (OEN number can be found in the child's day school progress report) and other information related to health such as medical condition and allergies. Please note that there is a \$20 materials fee.

### Is there continuous registration?

Yes, students may continue to register after classes have started, provided there is space available.

### What does it cost?

A non-refundable materials fee of \$20 per student will be charged at the time of registration. To qualify for the reduced rate of \$10 per student, you must present a T5007 or a Social Assistance receipt. A copy must be submitted with the registration form to support this request.

### Is transportation provided?

Transportation is the parents'/guardians' responsibility as these programs are offered outside of regular school hours.

### Can a new language be added to a school?

Yes. If there are 23 students registered for the new language, we can offer that language at the school.

### What happens if a class is cancelled?

TDSB makes every effort to ensure all scheduled classes run. However, if we must cancel classes, you will be notified through your child's day school (if possible), on our website or on the radio.

### Do you have to be a TDSB student to attend one of these classes?

Although the program is primarily for TDSB students, we accept non TDSB students to our program.
