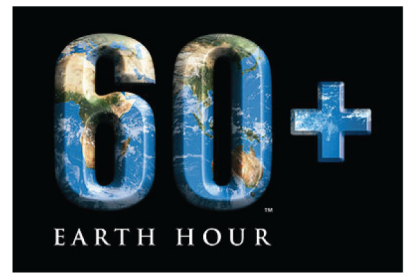

ACTIONS TO SAVE ENERGY DURING EARTH HOUR

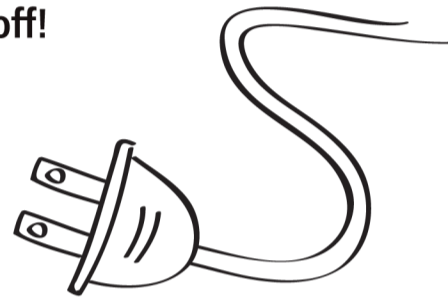
Turn off or unplug:
