



As of January 2018, the TDSB's Renewal Needs Backlog is \$4.05 billion. This is an alarming figure that represents the funding the TDSB needs to repair its schools. Without additional and predictable funding, the renewal needs backlog will continue to grow.

Nine TDSB schools have a Facilities Condition Index (FCI) higher than 100 percent. One of them, Milne Valley MS, is in **Don Valley East**. Although this rating **does not** reflect on the safety of the school building, the condition of our schools has an impact on our students, staff and communities.

Repairing these schools will cost more than replacing them which doesn't make sense for taxpayers or our students. Therefore, I am asking the Board to support sending a letter to the Premier and Minister of Education to request the Ontario Government to provide capital funding to replace all schools with an FCI of 100 percent or higher. These investments simply make sense as they will cost less and ensure our children have a better learning experience.
