Dear Parents/Guardians:

I am writing to inform you that at a meeting of the Board on Wednesday, November 25, 2015, the Board of Trustees of the Toronto District School Board made decisions regarding the Program Area Review that was recently completed for the Georges Vanier Cluster of Schools.

There are many changes described below and I would like you to know that transition planning to carry out the changes has already begun with a team of Principals and Teachers. We are committed to supporting the students through the implementation of the recommendations. Some areas that we will be focusing on include:

- Helping students prepare for and make successful transitions;
- Celebrating graduations for all Grade 5 and Grade 6 students as well as Grade 8 and Grade 9 students leaving their schools;
- Exploring child care possibilities for Grade 6 students at the middle schools; and
- Reviewing transportation needs, and safety concerns.

In summary, the following decisions have been made:

1. Grade Changes:

- a. The junior elementary schools (Crestview PS, Dallington PS, Forest Manor PS, Kingslake PS, Lescon PS and Seneca Hill PS) will become JK to Grade 5 schools for September 2017. In June 2017, the Grade 5 and Grade 6 students will graduate.
- b. Don Valley JHS and Woodbine JHS will become Grade 7 to 8 schools for September 2016 and Grade 6 to 8 schools for September 2017. In June 2016, the current Grade 8 and Grade 9 students will graduate.
 - The school names will change to Don Valley Middle School and Woodbine Middle School.
- c. Georges Vanier SS will become a Grade 9 to 12 school for September 2016.

2. Shift in French Programs Pathways:

- a. The French Immersion programs at Dallington PS, Brian PS and Cliffwood PS will become SK to Grade 5 for September 2017. In June 2017, the Grade 5 and Grade 6 students will graduate.
- b. The pathway from Don Valley MS for Grade 9 will become Windfields JHS, and then York Mills CI for Grades 10 to 12. In June 2016, the current Grade 8 and Grade 9 students will graduate.
- c. An additional guaranteed option will be provided to Don Valley MS French Immersion students to attend Newtonbrook SS for Grades 9 to 12 in 2016.

3. Shift in Special Education Programs:

- a. The pathway from Lescon PS and Seneca Hill PS for the Grades 6 to 8 Gifted Program will be Zion Heights MS and then the designated secondary school by home address. In June 2017, Grade 5 and 6 Gifted students will graduate.
4. Change to the Dallington PS Attendance Area West of Leslie Street:
 - a. This area will become part of the Lescon PS attendance area with the pathway to Don Valley MS and Georges Vanier SS for September 2016. All students who currently reside in this area and attend Dallington PS as of the end of the 2015-2016 school year, and their siblings, will be allowed to remain at Dallington PS until they graduate.
5. A future study will be conducted about the viability of a TOPS program at Georges Vanier SS.
