Dear Parents, Guardians and Community Members:

In June 2017, the Board of Trustees made decisions about a Pupil Accommodation Review which was done to address low enrolment at Dennis Avenue Community School, George Syme Community School, Harwood Public School, Lambton Park Community School, and Rockcliffe Middle School, along with facility conditions at Cordella Junior Public School, Dennis Avenue Community School, and Rockcliffe Middle School. At the time the decision was made, the Board indicated that there could be a potential delay in the construction of the new Dennis Avenue Community School and George Syme Community School addition.

I would like to inform you that the construction schedule for the new Dennis Avenue CS building has, in fact, been delayed and the school may not be completed until December 2022. Therefore, Dennis and Cordella students will not be moving into the new Dennis Avenue CS building until September 2023.

For Harwood, the timing of the boundary change to include the entirety of the shared Harwood/Cordella boundary will remain unchanged and will happen in June 2021. The table below outlines a year by year description of the grade range and program changes at Harwood PS

^{*}Changes to intensive French as a Second Language Programs were approved in June 2019 as part of the French Program Review. Existing Junior Extended French programs may transition into Middle French Immersion programs beginning in 2021-22.
