

## Summary of the Student Accommodation and Program Plan

### Overview:

- Change the grades of the feeder intermediate school from 7-9 to 6-8 to utilize available space, to address enrolment pressures at junior feeder schools, and to establish a feeder system that has consistent grade ranges and common entry and graduation points
- Change the grades of the feeder junior schools from JK-6 to JK-5 to address enrolment pressures and to establish a feeder system that has consistent grade ranges and common entry and graduation points
- Change the French Program locations and pathways to address enrolment pressures and utilize available space
- Change the Junior Attendance Areas to address enrolment pressures and utilize available space

### Details for each school:

#### Sir John A Macdonald CI

2016-17:

- No changes – school remains Grades 9-12 with a Regular Program

2017-18 (full implementation):

- Continue the Regular Program as Grades 9-12 – receive Grade 9 students from Pleasant View JHS

#### L'Amoreaux CI

2016-17:

- No changes – school remains Grades 9-12 with a Regular Program and an Extended French Program

2017-18:

- Continue the Regular Program as Grades 9-12 – receive Grade 9 students from Pleasant View JHS
- Continue the Extended French Program as Grades 9-12

2021-22 (full implementation):

- Continue the Regular Program as Grades 9-12
- Continue the Extended French Program as Grades 9-12 – receive Grade 9 students from a new feeder, Pleasant View MS

#### Pleasant View JHS

2016-17:

- Continue the Regular Program as Grades 7-9

2017-18:

- Change the grades of the Regular Program from 7-9 to 6-8 – send Grade 9 students to Sir John A Macdonald or L'Amoreaux CI depending on home address and receive Grade 6 students from Brian PS, Cherokee PS, Ernest PS and Muirhead PS

- Change the name of the school to Pleasant View Middle School to reflect the new grade range

2018-19:

- Continue the Regular Program as Grades 6-8
- Introduce an Extended French Program and receive Grade 6 students from Cherokee PS

2020-21 (full implementation):

- Continue the Regular Program as Grades 6-8
- Expand the Extended French Program to Grades 6-8 (program will feed into L'Amoreaux CI for 2021-22)

### **Brian PS**

2016-17:

- Continue the Regular Program as JK-6
- Continue the French Immersion Program as SK-6
- Change the Junior Attendance Areas of Brian PS, Ernest PS and Muirhead PS with grandparenting of existing students and their siblings (allow students attending these schools at the end of 2015-16 and their younger siblings to attend these schools until graduation)

2017-18 (full implementation):

- Change the grades of the Regular Program from JK-6 to JK-5 – send Grade 6 students to Pleasant View MS
- Change the grades of the French Immersion Program from SK-6 to SK-5 – send Grade 6 students to Don Valley MS (this change is made this school year to coincide with similar grade changes of the French Immersion Programs at Cliffwood PS and Dallington PS that were addressed in concurrent PARTs which also impact Don Valley MS) – see attached map

### **Cherokee PS**

2016-17:

- Continue the Regular Program as JK-6
- Establish an Extended French Program with the first intake of Grade 4 students

2017-18 (full implementation):

- Change the grades of the Regular Program from JK-6 to JK-5 – send Grade 6 students to Pleasant View MS
- Expand the Extended French Program to Grades 4-5 (program will feed to Pleasant View MS for 2018-19)

### **Ernest PS**

2016-17:

- Continue the Regular Program as JK-6
- Change the Junior Attendance Areas of Brian PS, Ernest PS and Muirhead PS with grandparenting of existing students and their siblings (allow students attending these schools at the end of 2015-16 and their younger siblings to attend these schools until graduation) – see attached map

2017-18:

- Change the grades of the Regular Program from JK-6 to JK-5 – send Grade 6 students to Pleasant View MS
- Introduce a new French Immersion Program with the first intake of SK students (could begin in 2016-17 if demand exceeds space available in nearby schools during the 2015-16 application process)

2022-23 (full implementation):

- Continue the Regular Program as JK-5
- Expand the French Immersion Program to SK-5 (program will feed into Don Valley MS for 2023-24)

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### **Muirhead PS**

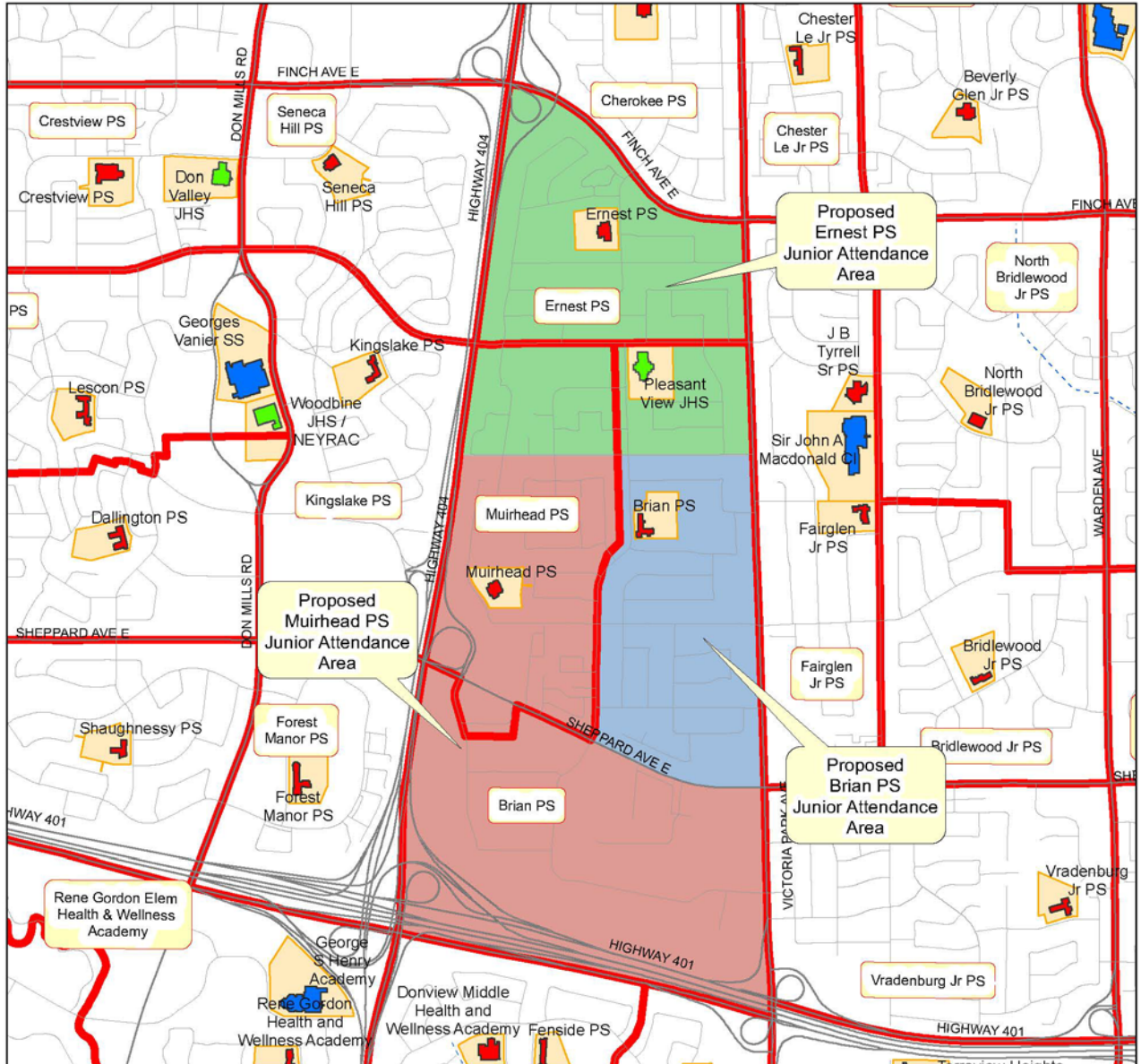
2016-17:

- Continue the Regular Program as JK-6
- Change the Junior Attendance Areas of Brian PS, Ernest PS and Muirhead PS with grandparenting of existing students and their siblings (allow students attending these schools at the end of 2015-16 and their younger siblings to attend these schools until graduation) – see attached map

2017-18 (full implementation):

- Change the grades of the Regular Program from JK-6 to JK-5 – send Grade 6 students to Pleasant View MS
