Or have fun in one of our great social clubs, including Spanish, French, drama, dance, photography, choral, chess, yearbook, newspaper and Fleming radio.



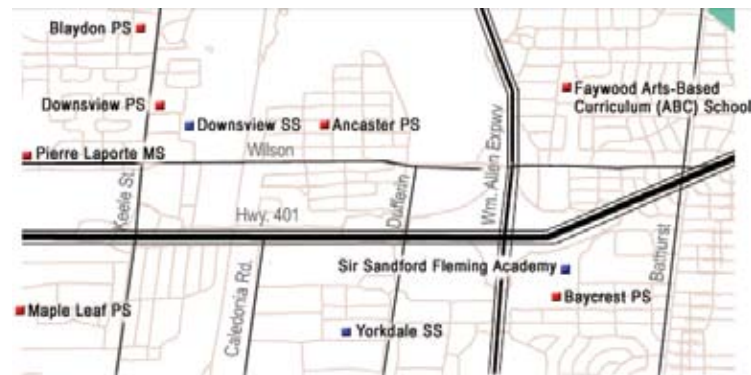

**Dance and Music** - We open the world of dance to you. Learn a wide range of global dances, in addition to North American and modern dance moves, in our professional studio equipped with a professional dance floor.

We have a wonderful steel band. Picture our steel band on stage and you see a wonderful collection of multinational drummers from south Asia, north Asia, Europe, Canada, the Caribbean and central and south America. Do you see yourself there? Or enroll in our music program and learn to play violin, piano, flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet or drums.



**Enriched Math and Science Program** - Take your learning to a higher level. Enroll in our after-school program and challenge your knowledge in mathematics and science. Choose to work with dedicated teachers to conduct research and produce exhibits for the challenging Waterloo math competitions. Math competitions are open to all students from Grades 9 to 12, while science competitions are open to students in Grades 11 and 12.

Our science students won medals at the University of Toronto's science fairs. In the past four years, our students have won opportunities to attend the prestigious Canadian Shadd Valley program. Our students return from the program telling us their world has changed.



**Computer Engineering** - No chalk-and-talk here! We offer very sophisticated courses in computer engineering to our Grade 11 and 12 students. Plan to develop your skills with hands-on projects. You will build interfaces, as well as disassemble and rebuild computers. We don't use software to teach Boolean algebra and circuit design; we use actual circuit boards. Starting in Grade 10, use of one of our robotic kits and build your own robot.

Get a head start. Our Grade 11 computer science program helps you prepare for university. When you start university, you will be well prepared for your first-year computer programming course.



**Credit Recovery** - If you struggle with parts of your compulsory courses, study only the portion you need without repeating the course. We incorporate our credit recovery program into your regular school day. We want to help you continue working toward success.

We offer you a wide range of co-operative education placement opportunities through our partnership with local businesses, agencies and the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP).

Gain valuable experience in law offices, the Royal Bank of Canada, the Canadian military, Toronto Police Service, elementary schools, hair salons and aesthetics studios, retail stores, Sunnybrook Hospital and the Baycrest Centre to explore a potential future career. For the skilled trades, earn high school credits while accumulating hours toward your apprenticeship program.

We have an exciting new justice services partnership offering new courses in phys-ed, science, photography and other social sciences courses such as a "criminology". More established co-op opportunities will emerge that commensurate with our C.A.S.T. vision focus.
