

The 2009 Learning Opportunities Index: Questions and Answers

Q1. *What is the Learning Opportunities Index (LOI)?*

- A1.** The LOI ranks each school based on measures of external challenges affecting student success. The school with the greatest level of external challenges is ranked #1 and is described as highest on the index. It is important to acknowledge that students in all schools have some external challenges, even those schools that are ranked very low on the LOI.

The LOI measures needs in a relative sense that compares all schools on exactly the same set of data collected in a consistent, reliable, and objective manner. The LOI removes the subjectivity that may enter into the perceptions of need that may be held about individual schools.

There are two indices, one for elementary (including junior high schools) and one for secondary.

Under various names, the Toronto District School Board (TDSB) and its legacy systems have calculated some variation of the index for over thirty years. After a year-long review and external consultation with stakeholders in 2007-2008, the current calculation of the index was recommended by a steering committee consisting of board staff and representatives from the Inner City Advisory Committee.

Q2. *Why has the LOI been developed?*

- A2.** Public education is designed to give all children an equal opportunity to succeed. The Toronto District School Board recognizes that students face varying degrees of challenge which can impact their opportunity to achieve high educational outcomes. Educational research has demonstrated that children from poorer families face more significant barriers in achieving high educational outcomes.

Because of its commitment to equity, the TDSB wants to ensure that every student has an equitable opportunity to succeed. This means ensuring all students have access to the resources to ensure their success. The LOI is TDSB's means of ensuring that children who have access to fewer resources at home and in their neighbourhoods will get a more equitable chance to succeed in their schools. The LOI will steer additional resources to the schools serving students who face greater challenges. This will help to ensure that every child has an equitable chance to achieve his or her academic potential.

Q3. *What are the components of the LOI?*

A3. The LOI is composed of variables which are combined into a single index. The variables used are:

1. **Median Income** -- A measurement of income levels, at which half the residents earn more and half of them earn less. This is measured at the level of the student's neighbourhood.
2. **Percentage of Families whose income is below Low Income Measure (before tax)** -- Also known as the Low Income Measure. The percentage of families in a student's neighbourhood whose income is at or less than half the median income in the city.
3. **Percentage of Families Receiving Social Assistance** -- The proportion of families in a student's neighbourhood whose income comes from government sources.
4. **Adults with Low Education** -- The percentage of people in a student's neighbourhood without a high school diploma.
5. **Adults with University Degrees** -- The percentage of people in a student's neighbourhood with at least one university degree.
6. **Lone-Parent Families** -- The proportion of families with children living in a student's neighbourhood with a mother or a father with no spouse or common-law partner present.

Please note the variables described above in 1, 2, 3, and 6 are based on data about families with children.

Q4. *Why use these variables and not others?*

A4. The variables in the LOI are variables that studies about educational achievement have identified as external challenges. They include measures of income and poverty, parents' education, and proportion of lone-parent families.

The variables that constitute the LOI have been tested against the student success indicators of TDSB students and have been shown to correlate with measures such as EQAO Grade 3 and 6 test results, OSSLT, and credit achievement.

The LOI is one of the TDSB's ways to respond to external challenges to get students to the same starting line. In the calculation of the LOI, the challenges which most strongly track with poor educational outcomes were selected.

Over the past few years, a number of other variables have been considered for inclusion in the LOI, but have not been included.

For some variables (for example, crime), ways to consistently link the information to each student are not available (student-level information serves as the basis of the LOI). For others such as crowding, there is no clear consensus in the literature on the importance of what the variable is, or whether it has any noticeable effect on student achievement. Lastly, some other proposed variables were too blunt a measure, and do not show a strong correlation to student achievement.

The variables used in the LOI will be periodically re-evaluated. It is possible that in the future, as new data becomes available, the Board will approve a change in the variables that are included in the LOI.

Q5. *The LOI in past years included recent immigration as a variable. Why doesn't the 2009 LOI include it?*

A5. This variable was not included because research and analysis of TDSB data shows that immigration status is not well correlated with student achievement. Some groups of recent immigrants show higher achievement levels than Canadian-born students, so status as a recent immigrant per se is not a valid measure of external challenge to student success.

It is important to note that resources to address the major challenge of recent immigrants – language learning – are provided through funding for English Language Learners (formerly called ESL). Resources for English Language Learners are distributed based on the number of students in each school who are recent immigrants from countries where English is not a main language.

Q6. *The LOI review recommended that a variable addressing race and ethnicity should be considered. Why doesn't the 2009 LOI include it?*

A6. The LOI staff steering committee considered the inclusion of a variable addressing race and ethnicity; however, a reliable data source for every student is not yet available. Information from external sources (for example, Statistics Canada) is not detailed enough to be applied accurately to every school. TDSB's Student Census has been completed for Grades 7 to 12. Once TDSB's Student Census has been completed for all students, and its results analyzed, race and ethnicity will be reviewed for inclusion as a variable.

On February 11, 2009, the Board decided that staff should develop recommendations about ongoing collection of data used in the student census to provide a richer foundation for impact on the Learning Opportunities Index; and

that staff should develop recommendations about the use of race and ethnicity in the Learning Opportunities Index. These recommendations will be brought to the Board as soon as analysis and consultation can be completed, most likely in the fall of 2009.

Q7. *How does the Canada Census data connect to the students in our school?*

A7. We are able to obtain postal code data for each student from our Student Information System (SIS); however, some variables such as income are appropriately protected by privacy legislation and cannot be collected. As a result, most of the measures use a more indirect route: taking the postal code of where the student lives, and linking it with information from already-existing sources.

For income, the postal code of each student is linked to tax returns of all families with school-aged children living in that postal code. For other variables such as the proportion of lone-parent families and education, the postal code is linked to information from the Canada Census (from the immediate neighbourhood or dissemination area in which the student lives).

Therefore, all measures in the index have a connection with the student based on the neighbourhood in which the student lives.

Q8. *Why is it that the school down the road has a very different LOI ranking even though both schools are in the same neighbourhood and look much the same?*

A8. The LOI is calculated from the characteristics of the students attending a school, and not from the characteristics of the area around the school. This is important to remember because in many cases, students will not come from the immediate neighbourhood of the school. For example, the school may be located in an area of comparative affluence, but many of the students may come from apartment buildings several blocks away, or may be bussed or take transit. The information about the student is gathered from the location of where the student lives. It is therefore difficult to tell how the school will be ranked on the LOI from its location.

Q9. *Why is my school lower on this LOI than the previous LOI, but the students appear to be just as needy and at-risk as before?*

A9. The LOI is a measure of relative need; it provides a comparison with other schools at a point in time. Students in a particular school may have exactly the same level of need as in the past, but this does not mean that the LOI score will remain exactly the same. The LOI score for a particular school is also influenced

by changes that may have occurred in other schools. It may be that the needs of students in several other schools have increased over time to a greater degree leading to a reduction of the LOI ranking for a school where the actual or absolute level of need has remained exactly the same.

Q10. How is the LOI used?

A10. There is a wide range of applications of the LOI within TDSB to help determine allocation of staffing and other resources to schools. During the staffing allocation process, the LOI is used as one input along with other types of information such as headcount or full-time equivalent (FTE) of school enrolment.

The Board has approved a policy to allocate resources at the school level according to the LOI, unless a better method exists to direct allocations to needs they are intended to address.

Q11. What has changed in the most recent (2009) Index?

A11. Many schools will see their position shift with this most recent LOI. Shifts could occur because of three main factors:

- New variables with a proven higher correlation to student achievement;
- New and more current Census data included; and
- The normal year-over-year shifts in school population and boundaries which affect the scores.

The LOI has been strengthened with the inclusion of new variables that show a stronger correlation to challenges to student achievement and the elimination of weaker variables. The new LOI continues to use median income but strengthens poverty measures by adding the percentage of families who fall below Statistic Canada's Low Income Measure (those living with incomes that are less than half the median Canadian income) as well as the measure of families receiving social assistance. Educational research shows that low income is one of the main drivers of poor academic performance.

Three variables including housing, immigration, and mobility have been dropped because they did not show a high correlation with student success.

In the 2009 LOI, all census information comes from the 2006 Census (previous indices used data from the 1996 and 2001 censuses). A few more differences are apparent as the number of students attending each school has changed or school boundaries have been modified.

Despite these changes, there is a strong correlation between the current LOI and the LOI produced two years ago. The correlation between the two indices is 0.900 for the secondary school index and 0.832 for the elementary school index.

Q12. *The new variables will result in shifts in rankings of schools. How will TDSB address the impact of these changes?*

A12. It is recognized that it is necessary to mitigate the impacts of the new LOI for a small number of schools that have a significant shift in rank.

To smooth the impact for individual schools experiencing a significant loss in resources as a result of the new index, two approaches will be used. The Staffing Allocation Committee will use discretion to mitigate changes. Also, Superintendents of Education will have some flexibility within their Families of Schools to make adjustments in staff allocations, and other resources distributed at the Family of Schools level.

Q13. *How does the LOI address year-over-year changes in schools?*

A13. The LOI is recalculated every two years.

In some instances, year-over-year changes in a specific variable could result in a significant shift in a school's ranking. Sometimes these changes are short-lived and are seen only in one specific year.

In the past, to counteract one-time swings that occur in a small number of schools each year, the LOI was calculated using a rolling three-year average of data for each of the variables in the index. For 2009, a two year average was used for data for each of the variables since many of the variables are new and data is not available for three years.

The three-year average approach will be used in future years.

Q14. *What is the relationship of the LOI to student achievement?*

A14. There is, in general, a relationship between the LOI and student achievement but the relationship is not absolute. Looking at all schools, the new LOI is more highly correlated to student achievement than in the past.

It should be emphasized that the LOI does not use student achievement in its calculation.

Q15. *How accurate is the LOI?*

A15. The LOI is extremely accurate. The external review of the LOI found that it is well suited to its purpose and that the statistical methods used in its construction are sound. As noted above, changes in the 2009 LOI make it even more strongly correlated with external challenges to student achievement.

The accuracy of the LOI depends on the accuracy of the information provided by students and parents; the accuracy of the information entered by schools into our student information system (SIS); and on the accuracy of the data that it is linked to (the Postal Code Conversion file, tax data, the Census). For example, many components of the LOI are derived by linking data to the postal code of student residence. Postal code data is complete for 99% of student records; however, in some schools the proportion of missing data is higher than 1%, while others have no missing records. At this time, there is no way to check on the validity of postal code compared to address, so that if a postal code is entered incorrectly, it will incorrectly link to tax and census data.

Since responding to the Census is a legal requirement, there is no reliable way to confirm the completeness of Census data. If Census forms are not completed, the local population can be “undercounted.”

The extent of such inaccuracies and the impact they may have on LOI rankings cannot be determined accurately. With this caveat, however, we are confident that the LOI is an accurate representation of the differences among schools and well correlated with external challenges to student achievement.
