- Support the development of social skills of students
- Assist with the organization and preparation of educational materials and teaching aids
- Assist in providing a safe learning environment for students

- Secondary School diploma with 6 months related experience working with children
- Fluency in oral and written English and French languages
- Ability to communicate in a sensitive, courteous manner with students, parents, staff and the general public
- Ability to work independently within a classroom program in partnership with a Teacher
- Ability to work with children in programs from Senior Kindergarten through to Grade 8
- Ability to take initiative
- Prior experience working with curriculum is an asset
- Understanding of one or more cultures whose first language is French is an asset
- Current First Aid and CPR certifications are assets
