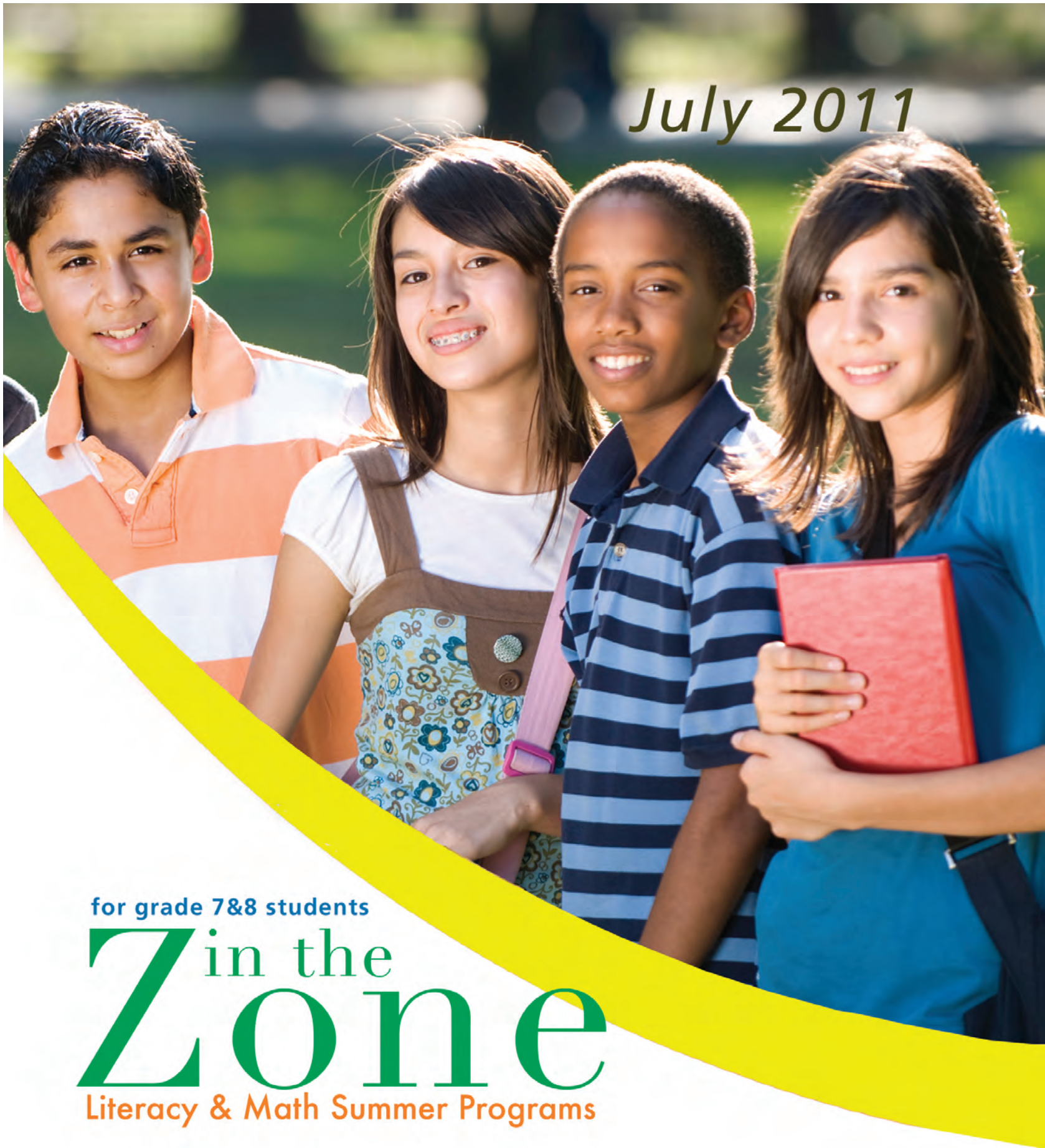

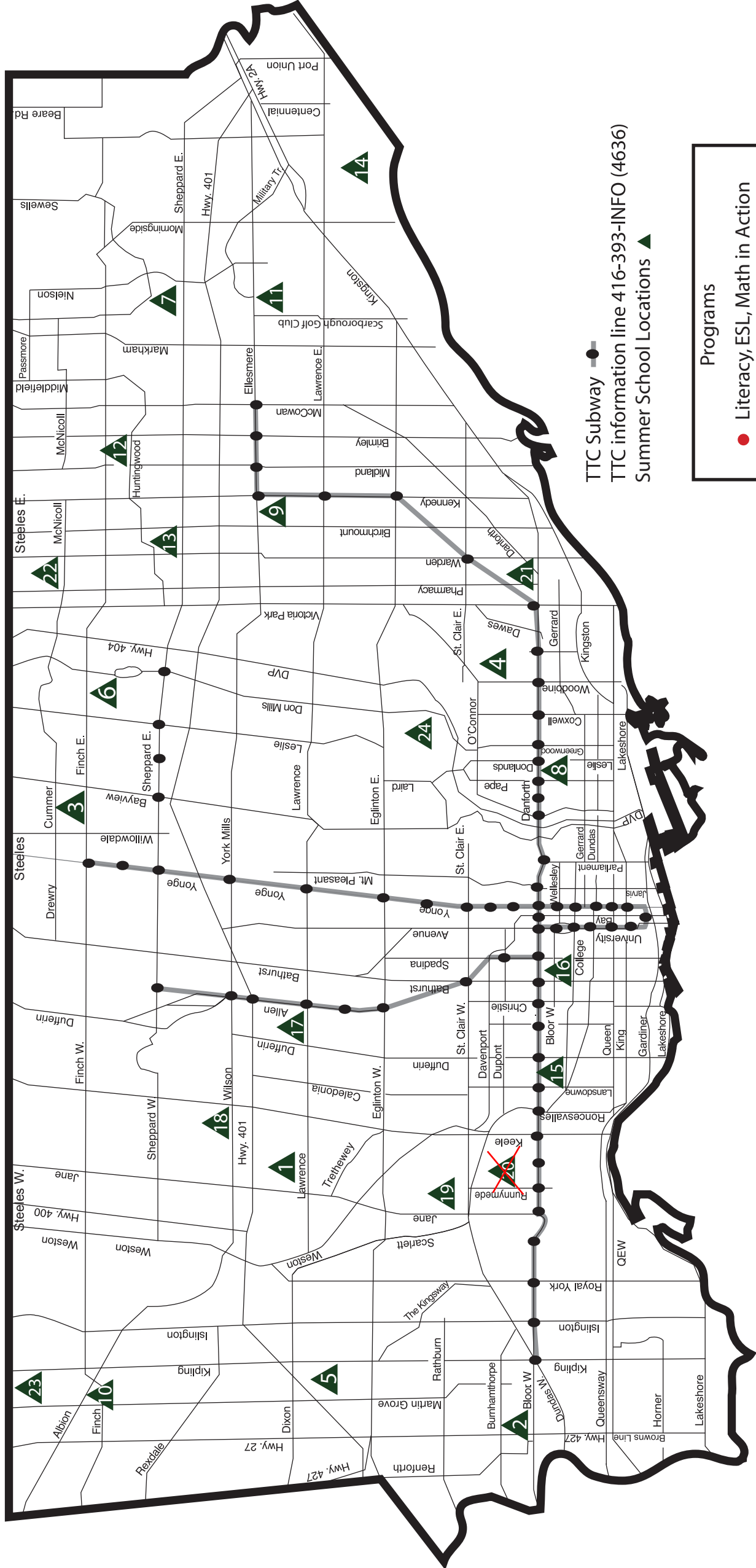

FREE TTC Tickets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Student TTC tickets will be distributed to all students registered and attending a program at a location that is not their home school. ▪ Please note that students must have a valid TTC student card. ▪ Tickets will be distributed at the summer school location.
Student Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All students must be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ currently registered in a TDSB school in grades 7 or 8 (as of June 2011); ○ achieving at Level 2 or below (C or less) on the March 2011 report card in literacy and/or numeracy or; ○ achieving at Stage 2 or below in English as a Second Language. ▪ All registrations must be signed by the day school Principal. ▪ If you have questions regarding your child’s eligibility, please discuss this with your child’s day school teacher and/or Principal.
Class Size	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Summer school classes have approximately 20 students per teacher. ▪ Additional classroom support is not available.
Student Attendance/Conduct	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Daily attendance ensures that every student has the opportunity to be successful. ▪ All students are expected to attend for the entire program. ▪ If the student will be absent for 3 consecutive days during the program, the student should not be registered for this program or he/she may be demitted from the program. ▪ The TDSB Student Code of Conduct will be adhered to during the summer school program.
Registration Form	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Parents/guardians must complete and sign the registration form. ▪ Please ensure that the program you select is available at the location you choose. ▪ Return the completed registration form to your student’s teacher and/or school office.
Registration Deadlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Friday May 6, 2011 - all student registration forms are to be returned to the student’s day school teacher and/or school office by this date. ▪ All eligible students whose registrations are received on or before Friday May 6, 2011 will be accepted to the summer program.
Late Registration Policy & Deadlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Student registration forms received between May 9 and June 3, 2011 will be marked “late”. ▪ A “late letter” will be mailed to the home address from Continuing Education and these students will be eligible to register on the second day of classes, Wednesday July 6, 2011, if there is room available in the class. ▪ No student registrations will be accepted after June 3, 2011. ▪ Walk-in registrations will be not accepted at summer school locations.
