Hazardous wastes are those materials that may be injurious to persons or the environment if not handled and disposed of properly.

- ▶ Classroom-generated wastes include batteries, science and photographic chemicals, biological specimens, automotive shop waste. Removal of this waste is the principal's responsibility.
- ▶ Caretaking wastes include batteries, waxes, strippers, cleaners, disinfectants. Their removal is the responsibility of the head caretaker.
- ▶ The cost of disposal is the responsibility of Health and Safety.
- ▶ Community hazardous waste collection events are not supported by the Board or the City's Toxic Taxi. Instead, collected waste should be delivered to a City of Toronto household hazardous waste depot.
