Two options are available for disposing of your old, broken, or energy-inefficient stoves, dishwashers, washers, dryers, refrigerators, and freezers.

1. Collection of used appliances upon delivery of new appliances

When you purchase a new appliance from Midnorthern Appliance (through the TDSB), you have the option to have old appliances removed for a fee of \$10.00 each for refrigerators and freezers. All other appliances can be removed at no charge. You must choose this option at the time of creating your Contract Release Order (CRO) in SAP.

Please note:

- ▶ Appliances such as dishwashers and microwaves that are built-in are not available for this option.
- ▶ Washing machines must be empty of water and clothing before removal.
- ▶ It is not necessary to remove appliance doors.
- ▶ Midnorthern Appliance will not collect microwaves. They can be managed through Valu Shred, which also collects computers and other electronics, or through the City of Toronto (see next page).
- ▶ Collection costs are the responsibility of the school or department requesting the pick-up.

2. Collection of used appliances and scrap metal by the City of Toronto

The City will collect used appliances upon request.

1. Call Customer Services at 416.338.2010.
2. Provide the City with your school name, address, contact person, phone number, and number and type of appliances to be collected.
3. The City will indicate the collection day and provide a confirmation number for tracking purposes.
4. Place appliance(s) at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day or the night before. There is no cost for this service. Your region's Task Force can be used to move appliances outside.

Please note:

- ▶ **IMPORTANT** All doors must be removed from appliances before they are set out.
- ▶ The City is responsible for removing freon from refrigerators.
- ▶ There is a limit of two appliances per month per site.
- ▶ Metal items such as microwave ovens, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, storage sheds, bicycles, metal chairs with seats and backs removed, etc. can be picked up with the appliances. There is a limit of 5 metal items per month in addition to the appliances.
- ▶ Schools can arrange for a separate scrap metal pick-up, minimum 10 items, using the above process. Remove any non-metal components before placing the items at the curb.
