Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I make a donation online?

Parents/guardians and members of the community can now donate to school fundraising initiatives online. If you would like to donate to a particular school fundraising initiatives, please visit https://tdsb.schoolcashonline.com/Fee/Index, select the school, and indicate the purpose of the donation. For more detailed instructions on making a donation online, please see the step by step instructions.

2. How much of the donation amount does the school receive? Are there any administration charges?

The Board incurs nominal merchant fees on credit card and debit card donations. The actual cost of the merchant fees will be charged to the school against gross donations received. On average, this is between 0% to 2% of the donation amount, depending on the payment method and the type of credit card used by the donor. Donors will still receive a tax receipt showing 100% of the amount they donated. The funds will be deposited into the school's donations account.

3. Can I use this module to pay for pizza lunches or other school fees?

No. The online donation webpage is for monetary donations only. The TDSB is also implementing a School Cash Online system for collection and recording of school generated funds. The goal is for all schools to implement School Cash Online by the 2019-2020 school year. You will receive information from your Principal once the system has been implemented at your school.
