Context

At a meeting on 6 February 2019, the Board voted to approve the recommendation of the Program and School Services Committee, dated 16 January 2019, *Early Years Community Advisory Committee: Indigenous Cultural Competency Training and Resources* (see Agenda Item 19.2(3), PSSC Report No. 72), thereby referring the following recommendation of the EYCAC back to staff for exploration:

“EYAC recommends that be it resolved that the feasibility of offering training and resources to support the development of Indigenous Cultural Competency among our early years school- based stakeholders be explored.”

The feasibility of this recommendation was explored with staff of the Urban Indigenous Education Centre (UIEC), and currently, due to limited resources, UIEC staff are not able to provide the requested training.
