Recommendation

It is recommended that the term of the community use agreement into which the Director has been authorized to enter with the City of Toronto, for playground improvements to a portion of the lands at Oriole Park Public School, be changed from fifteen years to twenty years.

Context

At its 23 May 2018 meeting, the Board of Trustees authorized the Director to enter into a Community Access Agreement with the City of Toronto for a term of fifteen years with regard to an allocation of \$350,000 for playground improvements at Oriole Park Junior Public School.

In the Toronto City Council motion authorizing the allocation of Section 37 funds for this project, City staff is directed to draw up the Community Access Agreement in consultation with the local City Councillor.

In the process of attempting to finalize the community use agreement, the City has notified the Board that it wants a twenty-year term, not the fifteen year term cited in the 23 May 2018 report to the Board of Trustees.

Action Plan and Associated Timeline

The timelines associated with the following milestones are estimates:

- Finalize community use agreement negotiations with the City of Toronto: April/May 2019
- TDSB and City of Toronto sign the agreement: May/June 2019
- City of Toronto transfers the money to the TDSB: June 2019
- Construction start date: July 2019
- Date for completion: December 2019

Resource Implications

The playground improvement project will be funded by the City.
