The advantage of our small school is the special one on-one support you receive. Our child and youth counsellor meets with you each week, helping you build self-esteem and develop coping skills.

We are an excellent transitional school that helps you get back on track and return to a traditional or alternative high school. Parents tell us how valuable our program is to their children. **Holiday Breaks** As a school open throughout the full year, we provide five school breaks. The holidays rejuvenate our students and help them feel enthused for the next session. Generally, our timetable offers the following breaks: 1. November: Two-week holiday 2. December: Two-week holiday following all TDSB high schools' timetable 3. February: Two-week holiday following session exams in January 4. May: Two-week holiday. We do not provide a March break 5. Mid July to mid August: Summer break
