- **Tuition Fee** is to be made payable to the **Toronto District School Board** by certified cheque, bank draft, money order in Canadian currency or through wire transfer. **Please add \$40.00 CDN bank service charge if you're paying by wire transfer.**
- **Health Insurance is included in the tuition fee.** Comprehensive health insurance is mandatory in Ontario and every international student must have this coverage while studying in Toronto.

**REFUND POLICY FOR TUITION FEE**

- A full tuition fee refund, less the administration fee (CAD\$500.00), will be granted if Citizenship and Immigration Canada does not issue the Study Permit. To obtain a refund, the student must provide:
  1. Copy of the Letter of Rejection from Citizenship and Immigration Canada
  2. Copy of the TDSB Official Letter of Acceptance
  3. Copy of the original receipt of tuition payment
  4. A written refund request by the parent with signature including the name and address of the cheque recipient.
- There will be no refund of the tuition fee in the following circumstances:
  - if the student chooses to withdraw for reasons other than the Study Permit has been denied by Citizenship and Immigration Canada
  - if the student is found in violation of school regulations and asked to withdraw from the school
  - if false medical information was given and conditions were not disclosed
- In the event that the student's immigration status changes during the school year, the parent of the student is to contact the International Students and Admissions Office immediately.
