Semester Start and End Dates

- September November
- November February
- · February April
- April June
- * Each semester is 9 weeks in duration and students can take up to 3 credits.



Tuition Fees

- Each credit is \$2,000
- 2 credits per semester (9 weeks, 4 hours per day) \$4,000
- Full academic year 10 months (8 credits) \$16,000
- * Tuition fees include: health insurance coverage, materials, and participation fees.
