- Ensure regular communication between PIAC, school councils, and administrators
- Establish clear communication channels with school administrators and staff

## Goal 3: Supporting School Councils in their Engagement and Advocacy

- Provide training on parent engagement, advocacy, and policy analysis
- Offer advocacy toolkits, including structured funnels for effective advocacy
- Ensure councils receive a comprehensive "Welcome Package"
- Provide access to childcare, translation, and other support services for events
- Act as a supportive resource for councils, offering guidance and helping with organizational challenges
- Facilitate ward-level connections and create opportunities for PIAC reps and school councils to interact regularly
- Organize mentorship programs where experienced council members can support newer councils
- Address participation challenges by offering flexible meeting options and building a digital parent community
