	Questions from parents and community have been collected and sent to TDSB staff for answers:
	Q: Academics are required for all programs? What's the basic or minimum for academic marks?
	Report marks are required. Parents have concerns for the requirement of report cards, especially Music for languages marks - What about ESL learners?
	Q: Were marks considered before P100 lottery for Art Focus?
	A: Individual decisions by schools before CSIP, will confirm with specialized schools if they took mark into consideration before lottery enrollment.
	Q: Who will be responsible for looking and scoring the Arts auditions? Will the specific school that a student is applying to, be doing this?
	Q: Art portfolio will be submitted online, will it be very different for students who can't afford professional photography for dances ect. How do we ensure the visual arts are not Al generated?
	Q: Are marks ranked? Is everyone 70% and above considered, or if you have a 90% is that ranked higher than a student with a 70%.
	Q: If students are currently from outside TDSB, will their report cards be valid for application or they are less likely to be considered?
	Q: How many students from model schools applied to the CSIP lottery vs. before the lottery? What will the Board do to address historic inequities in this new process?
	Q: Should schools delay open houses, given how little application details are available?

	Q: What will happen to the students entered through the lottery? Are they given support to stay through?  Q: When will the TDSB research team be able to provide an update regarding LOI consultation?
