<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Need regular updates from the Supervisor through staff to PIAC directly ○ Allow parents an option to request the principal raise caps raised to avoid splits if it's a matter of one or two students ○ Will TDSB host another budget townhall? ○ Student and Parent Support Office was supposed to be announced mid January but we haven't heard anything yet - need clarity. ○ It's increasingly difficult to get adequate janitorial in a parent's model school in Ward 17. Numbers, being able to cover the school with headcount provided, as well as daily nightly clean-up. Caretaker in Ward 22 - unable to do the job. Unable to take care of the school; her daughter refuses to use the bathroom; shingles falling off the roof. Putting salt out; hazardous winter conditions make janitorial staff urgent. ○ AntiPalestinian racism - has not been addressed; trustees in april/may voted to address APR as part of combatting hate and racism; what is going to happen to that vote. ○ Plans to review Policies and vendors to become a TDSB partner - \$500-600 for small businesses is onerous not bringing realistic atmosphere; ○ Working with the city to get a sign put up. Is there an office in the TDSB to allow council to more easily improve safety in the community. ○ What is the plan to increase long term supply teachers ○ Parent escalation protocol - how has it changed now that there are no trustees and how will the new Student and Parent Support Offices. ○ Data on how many people applied to student interest programs. ○ Review on amount of time social workers are in schools; having to be counselors at the same time. ● Parent from Ward 17 - concerned about gatekeeping parents from the same household limiting SAC participation; Vim and Caryn from Ward 22; also Thomas G. agreed they had the same issue. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Parents advised to recruit new parents to School Council; referred to SC Support WG.
