School Council (SC)

Innovation Grant

Councils continue to implement the grant. All funds must be goods received by May 15, 2026, and the final report submitted by June 19, 2026. Currently, **70.6 %** of the reporting schools have officially started their projects. The remaining **29.4 %** have outlined their initial steps, such as securing permits, contacting vendors, or designing promotional materials, and are prepared to begin shortly.
