TDSB New Organization Structure and PCEO

- Effective September 2018 the PCEO will be located within the Equity, Well-Being, and School Improvement Department and reporting to a Superintendent...not yet announced
- The responsibility for Community Advisory Committees will be shifted to Board Services
- To date, PIAC will continue to be supported by the PCEO.

2017/18 PRO Grant Reporting:

Schools that received PRO Grant funding for the 2017-2018 school year must ensure that the following steps are completed:

- Spend all PROG funds by June 30, 2018
- Charge all PROG funds against CC# XXXX0565 and GL#41500, under the Plan column
- Complete and return the Declaration Form (the contract between the school council and the Ministry of Education) to the Ministry of Education
- File all receipts at the school according to the Board policy (as government funded initiatives are subject to audit, these records must be retained for seven (7) years)
- Complete the final report on-line at <http://education.factorial.ca> by **August 31, 2018**.

Toronto Student Transportation Group

The Toronto Student Transportation Group – “TSTG” (the transportation Consortium that provides busing services to both the Toronto District School Board and Toronto Catholic School Board) has some significant changes to announce:

- TSTG has procured a new student transportation management software system called BusPlanner by GeoRef. This new tool will replace TRACS. BusPlanner Web application will be the new tool to look up student transportation information. A short tutorial at <https://portal.torontoschoolbus.org/training/busplanner-intro.mp4> has been provided to help parents through the basic steps and screens in the new BusPlanner software that will be available in August. This also means **that parents will have to register for the new transportation portal in order for them to access their children’s transportation information**.
