The Extended Day Program Summer Camp provides fun and learning for children from Kindergarten to Grade 6. The summer camp program is delivered by TDSB staff, Designated Early Childhood Educators.

Campers will participate in both indoor and outdoor activities so dress appropriately for the weather and bring sunscreen! Two nutritious snacks will be provided but all children must bring their own lunch and refillable water bottle.
