In an increasingly globalized world, it is important to set our students on the path to being active global citizens. This fall, the International Languages – Elementary / African Heritage Program will be offering African Heritage classes to students (TDSB and non TDSB) in Kindergarten to Grade 8.



Students will take part in a remote/at home learning and will learn about Black culture and the contributions of people of African descent. Classes run 2.5 hours, one day a week. Students will have live face-to-face interactive lessons with their instructor and other students for approximately 30 minutes. Remaining time will be spent on independent work.
