GENERAL OVERVIEW

This position is responsible for supervising students with a developmental disability during the lunch period. Supervision and assistance are tailored to the individual needs of each student and reinforce the student's educational program. These students have high risk and complex needs; they have very limited abilities to direct their own physical care or to advocate for themselves.

- Assist with student feeding, preparation of lunch, table manners, cutlery use, self-feeding, proper chewing/swallowing
- Supervise and assist in the clean-up of the lunch area and assist students in personal hygiene and grooming activities
- Toilet students of all ages, including lifting and transferring, washing, diapering, changing clothes etc
- Assist the special education teachers(s) in addressing and meeting the physical safety needs of student(s), e.g. BMS techniques, behaviour shaping, prompting strategies, proximity control, etc

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- Completion of Grade 10
- three months related experience supervising children with special needs, or an equivalent combination of education and experience
- Ability to use adaptive equipment (e.g. wheelchair operation, walkers)
