Semester Start and End Dates

September – November

November – February

February – April

April – June

Each semester is 9 weeks in duration and students can take up to 3 credits.

Tuition Fees

Each credit is \$2,000

2 credits per semester (9 weeks, 4 hours per day) \$4,000

Full academic year – 10 months (8 credits) \$16,000

Tuition fees include: health insurance coverage, materials, and participation fees.
