



- Immunization Record
- Newcomer Profile
- Proof of Address (2 or 3; such as hydro bill or bank statement) (for elementary students only)
- Custodianship Documents
- Custodian and Homestay: Phone #s and email

Attendance

Students must be in school everyday

- 24 hour voicemail available at all schools
- Absences <u>verify with a note or call</u> prior to absence and upon the student's return
- Absence = phone call home
- Planned absence = note ahead of time
- Students leaving during the day <u>MUST be signed</u> out in the main office

Expectations for Parents / Custodians

- Regular communication regarding student progress

 - attend interviews, presentations, concerts
 - help student prepare for school (sleep, nutrition)
 - communicate with parents regularly
 - monitor student's progress, check homework, tests etc.
 - you may request a meeting with the teacher at any time
 throughout the year
 - Make sure that students renew and make payments on time
