Summer Sounds

Perform in a concert band, string orchestra, or chamber strings. As well as guitar ensemble, jazz ensemble, woodwind ensemble, percussion ensemble or brass ensemble. They will also have the choice of learning how to play the guitar, keyboard, a second band or string instrument, use GarageBand to compose, sing in a choir, or bucket drumming.

Registration:

Students who have completed grades 4,5,6,7,8, or 9 as of June 2020 are eligible to register for the Summer Sounds Music Camp. Students who are younger than Grade 4 are too young to be enrolled in this music camp. Register early as spaces are limited to the first 100 students and classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Each student needs to have a band or string instrument for the Experienced Homeroom periods. You have a few options to fulfill this requirement:

- a. bring your own instrument from home; or
- b. borrow an instrument from your school.

Instruments for all other classes will be provided by Summer Sounds.
