Tips for Successful Job Search: In this 2-hour workshop, new clients will learn more about the services offered by the centre and get tips on how to effectively conduct their job search.

Resumes & Cover Letters: Two-hour workshop in person. Please join us to ensure your cover letter and resume get seen by recruiters and Applicant Tracking System software. We will provide insider tips to make your resume gets you an interview!

One-on One Resume Review: This thirty-minute resume session that provides job seekers with the opportunity to receive professional feedback on their resumes from our Employment Specialist. Participants must attend the 2-hour workshop and bring their update resume with a job posting to this appointment.

Interview Preparation: In this 2-hour workshop. Participants will get tips on various types of interviews, interview questions and answers and how to be better prepared.

Group Practice Interview: In this session participants will receive additional support within a safe, and motivating group environment. Participants will learn within an experimental setting while practicing their interviewing skills.

Better Jobs Ontario Information Session: (formerly Second Career) Two- hour in-person workshop with an overview of the training programs, requirements, and general information. A referral from your Employment Advisor is required to ensure you qualify.

Communication Style at Work: In this workshop participant will conduct an assessment to better understand their preferred communication style, and how it can help them in their personal and professional life.

Personality Dimensions: This interactive workshop you will learn how understanding your personality can help you find your ideal job. This workshop is ideal for anyone thinking of returning to school or changing careers.
