Admission Criteria

- University degree

Program Fees

- Tuition for 2022-2023 is \$4,000.00 including HST. This includes all required course texts and materials. Payment may be made by credit/debit card, certified cheque, or bank draft.
- Course fees are tax deductible.
- Tuition fees will be refunded to students who withdraw before the first class. However, a \$100 non-refundable processing fee applies.


