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PCEO UPDATES

Program Priorities Funding (PPF) –Parent Reaching Out Grant (PROG)

School Council Grant PPF Application -this grant was provided to School Councils to address Anti-Black Racism, anti-Indigeneity, and anti-oppression. There were 190 applications submitted and 80 were approved of which 6 were high schools, 11 Middle Schools, and 63 elementary schools. Of the 80 approved, 61 were supported by the PPF Grant for a total of \$76, 563.00 and 19 by PIAC allocated funds for a total of \$25,000. An interim report was shared with approved applicants and only one school to date has indicated that they will not be able to use funds due to limited council capacity, time-frame, and availability of speakers. A list of all council funds have been attached to the report outlining Council spending as of May 04, 2021.

School Council Update

School Messenger- Staff continues to work with the company to address the glitches in the program.

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ZOOM Accounts-While Councils continue to activate and access the communication tools, whether e-mail account, ZOOM etc., we are seeing a slow and limited uptake of ZOOM and e-mail accounts. We will continue to work to provide more immediate supports where and when necessary, while continuing communication plan with SCs to improve the number of councils using the tools.

School Council Bylaw Review-TDSB will be meeting with staff and PIAC representatives to explore strategies for supporting Councils in developing equitable and inclusive bylaws that addresses Human Rights and clearer conflict resolution processes. PIACs Consultation Working Group has referred PIAC representatives for the meeting.

Adding PIAC Rep Names to School websites

At its March 10 2021 meeting the Board decided that the names of the Parent Involvement Advisory Committee ward representatives for each ward be added to the TDSB school websites, adjacent to or below the current PIAC logo and link, and that these names be linked to the representative's PIAC email address. TDSBs web team has commenced the work and anticipation a June 2021 completion.

PO23-Policy Review

A report on reconvening PO23 policy review was approved by the Board. The first roll out of the review will be the CAC review. Approved consultation Critical Path will be shared with the PIAC Consultation Working Group.

- The Ministry of Education has announced the launch of two new portals developed in partnership with TVO and TFO. TVO Learn and TFO IDÉLLO, apprendre à la maison will provide optional supplemental support for students who are self-screening, quarantining at home, or wishing to build their skills by accessing additional educational resources developed by Ontario certified teachers. These portals provide engaging and interactive ways to support students in furthering their learning in the Grades 1 to 8 Ontario curriculum from home.



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- Secondary students can continue to access TVO's Independent Learning Centre (ILC) Open House and Portes ouvertes pour les cours TVO ILC in French-language, which provide access to 144 Grade 9 to 12 courses. These ILC resources are not for credit but are designed to provide flexible learning opportunities to help students keep up with their learning or deepen their understanding of a specific subject. In addition, French-language students also have access to French-language online courses available through the Consortium d'apprentissage virtuel de l'Ontario.
