Date (PIAC Meeting)	May 18, 2020
Description/Objective	This ad hoc Working Group aims to provide recommendations on Parent/Family Engagement in the Virtual School. Areas of interest are Responsiveness, Communication, Community, Accountability, and relation with Home School Councils.
Update	<p>Since the last PIAC meeting (on April 20, 2021), the ad hoc Working Group met once, on May 17. <i>Attendance:</i> John Bakous, Chris Levien, Seema Mitchell; Kaydeen Bankasing (Co-Lead), Wilmar Kortleever (Co-Lead), D. Virtual School Resources.</p> <p>During the discussions, the Working Group concluded it was important that we get a fulsome impression for Virtual School parents/families how their year has been, what parent/family engagement they appreciated and what they lacked: see motion below.</p> <p>Separately, in hearing the news that the deadline for choosing between in-person school and remote learning was postponed, the Working Group felt strongly that the TDSB should organize a live, in-person, interactive forum, like a Town Hall, before the eventual deadline to choose. Such a forum reaches different people in a different way, in addition to any written, electronic communication media like e-mail and websites. The personal aspect also shows transparency and fosters trust.</p>
Motion	<p>Whereas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the 2020/2021 School Year has been challenging for all, but especially for students and families in the Virtual Schools, and - parent & family engagement in the Virtual School was slow to get off the ground, and still falls short of the engagement provided in the brick & mortar schools, <p>PIAC Recommends that the Toronto District School Board organize a survey or other consultation to ask all parents & families in the Virtual School for their feedback on parent(/guardian/caregiver) engagement during the past school year, including but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - general impression of the year - parent/family engagement that supported them (best practices) - parent/family engagement that was lacking (lessons/ideas to learn for next year) - parent/family engagement to implement in the 2021/2022 school year. <p>Results of this survey/consultation can be of great benefit in the 2021/2022 school year, especially given that many families are still expected to start with fully remote learning in September. That may be with a closer connection with the brick & mortar 'home school', but many of the drawbacks of virtual learning remain in terms of engagement, resources, and other.</p>

<p>Next Steps and Action items</p>	<p>Discuss items during our next Working Group Meeting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • November Recommendations Review – invite staff from the Virtual School. • Further discuss a proposed Recommendation to ask the TDSB to facilitate <i>Parent Connect</i> (Exchange of Contact Information between parents/guardians) for ALL parents (but especially those with students in virtual learning) by allowing parents/guardians to ‘opt in’ on exchanging contact information. • Further explore the inequities in the Virtual School Experience, including advocacy for more (equal) resource allocation. <p>PM</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ThoughtExchange; • Organize facilitated Conversations with parents in the Virtual School; • Develop further Virtual Engagement Recommendations, especially in the area of Accountability.
