

## THE 2023 LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES INDEX: TECHNICAL REPORT

The LOI is composed of variables which are combined into a single index. The variables are:

1. **Median Family Income** – A measurement of income levels, at which half the families earn more and half of them earn less. This is measured at the level of the student’s postal code aggregated to the school level.
2. **Percentage of Families Whose Income is Below the Low Income Measure (Before Tax)** – Also known as the Low Income Measure, this is the percentage of families in a student’s postal code aggregated to the school level whose income is at or less than half the median income in the city.
3. **Percentage of Families Receiving Social Assistance** – The proportion of families in a student’s postal code aggregated to the school level whose income comes from government sources.
4. **Adults without Secondary Education** – The percentage of adults (25-64 years of age) in a student’s postal code aggregated to the school level without a high school diploma.
5. **Adults with University Degrees** – The percentage of adults (25-64 years of age) in a student’s postal code aggregated to the school level with at least one university degree.
6. **Single-Parent Families** – The proportion of families aggregated to the school level where the parent/guardian does not live with either a spouse or common law partner. This also includes students living with their grandparents or other relatives.

### Methodology

The method of principal components is used to derive the LOI. Principal components analysis is generally used for two purposes:

- To reduce the number of variables
- To detect a structure in the relationships between variables.

Principal components analysis is appropriate when you have obtained measures on several observed variables (e.g., predictors of student achievement) and want to develop a smaller number of artificial variables (principal components) that will account for most of the variation in the observed variables.

It is particularly useful when there is some redundancy in the variables in the sense that some of the variables are correlated with each other (e.g., the calculation of the LOI uses low-income measure and families on social assistance and these two variables are highly correlated).

Principal components analysis weights the observed variables statistically according to their strength in predicting student achievement.

**Process**

First, a principal components analysis is run on our education variables. This is to generate a composite and have one singular education variable (see below).

Afterwards, the main principal components analysis is run on the remaining 4 components (median income, proportion of single-parent families, low-income measure, proportion on social assistance) and the combined education component.

Our extraction leads to 1 component because the current variables are so strongly correlated and that there are comparatively few of them.

The eigenvalues of all the components beyond the first one were very small (<0.5). Using Kaiser’s criterion - eigenvalue of 1 (which is a standard practice), we see only the first component meeting this criterion (see below).

77.53% of variance is explained for the 2023 LOI. The previous LOI (2020) had 77.65% of variance explained. Most literature points to a 60% threshold for an analysis to accepted as valid (for social sciences).

The signs of the component loadings are as expected where education (FAC1\_1 REGR factor score 1 for analysis 1) and median income (medinc) have negative signs (signifying lower challenge) while single-parent families (lonep\_tri), low income measure (lim) and social assistance (socass) have positive signs (signifying higher challenge) (see following page).

**LOI Mapping**

Over the years, TDSB Research has produced maps using Esri’s ArcGIS showing the extent of external challenge at our schools across the City of Toronto. Below are maps created using data from the last 4 LOI calculations. The overall pattern of challenge has not changed significantly over the decade shown<sup>1</sup>, but minor shifts can be seen in certain areas due to gentrification and other local factors (see following page).

- Areas coloured green are predominately high-income and lower challenged based on the 6 LOI factors.
- Areas coloured red are predominately low-income and higher challenged based on the 6 LOI factors.
- Areas coloured yellow are mainly middle-income and have mixed challenge based on the 6 LOI factors.

<sup>1</sup> This is in line with Dr. David Hulchanski’s “Three Cities within Toronto” model which shows the income polarization in Toronto’s neighbourhoods going as far back as 1970.





Most often minor rank changes occur over a staggered period as gentrification alters the socioeconomic makeup of the school neighbourhood, where typically most students live. As income, education, and proportion of single parents are the main components of the LOI, gentrification will have a strong effect on the calculation of the score and rank. Usually there is a pattern or trend for schools moving up and down the LOI over time.

The addition of new programming (e.g., French Immersion, Gifted, etc.) can also be a driver for an influx of students from outside of the traditional school boundaries. This can alter a school’s LOI ranking depending on what neighbourhoods the students are travelling from. The most drastic change to a school rank is typically due to this reason, as new students who may not have a similar socioeconomic background as the existing student body enters the student population.

**Example of Demographic Shift**

Heather Heights JPS is in Morningside which is a highly diverse (75% visible minority) neighbourhood in Scarborough that is south of Hwy 401 and to the west of the University of Toronto Scarborough Campus. This neighbourhood has a significant proportion of single-detached homes and proportionally fewer apartment complexes when compared with the City of Toronto.

Household incomes of the families at Heather Heights have on average increased significantly since the previous LOI, far outpacing the income growth of the TDSB overall student population (28% compared to 18%) (see previous page). This has had the effect of cutting the proportion of families below the low-income measure in half (from 47% in 2019 to 23% in 2022). All indicators above point to a rising socio-economic status in general for the population of Heather Heights JPS.

Note that since Heather Heights is a small school (<200 students), rank and score changes are more pronounced due to each student being worth proportionally more. Five students in a school of 150 can more drastically change the demographic make-up at a school than 5 students at a school of 500.

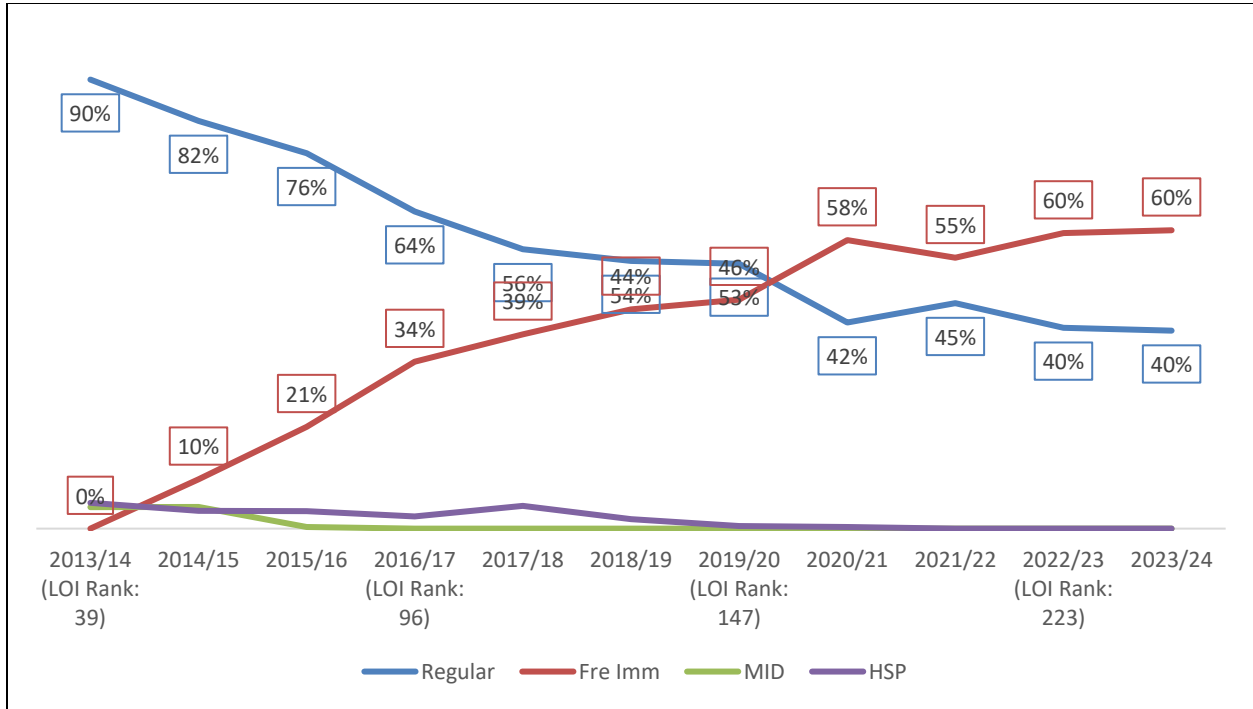
In October 2019, approximately 85% of the school population came from the same forward sortation area as the school (i.e., in the general school neighbourhood). In October 2022, approximately 95% of the school population came from the same forward sortation area as the school. This shows that Heather Heights is a neighbourhood school and neighbourhood demographics should reflect what is happening at the school. Unfortunately, City of Toronto data has not been refreshed from the 2016 Federal Census, but income data from that period correlates with our previous LOI in showing lower incomes then.

Overall, the shift in Heather Heights JPS LOI rank is due to the increasing incomes in the school neighbourhood which brings Heather Heights close to its historical ranking in 2011.

### Example of Program Shift

Blake JPS is in Blake-Jones which is a somewhat diverse (41% visible minority) neighbourhood in the central part of Toronto that is south of Danforth Avenue, bordered between Pape Avenue and Greenwood Avenue and north of the Canadian National Railway track. This neighbourhood has a significant proportion of semi-detached homes and proportionally fewer 5+ storey apartment complexes when compared with the City of Toronto.

Blake JPS introduced a French Immersion program in the 2014-15 school year. Initially students in the French Immersion program accounted for 10% of the student population but by 2023-24, students in French Immersion accounted for 60% of the student population. Also, during this period the student population of Blake JPS grew from 231 students in 2013-14 to 356 students by 2023-24.



As seen above, the increasing proportion of students in French Immersion programming correlates with the rank changes in the LOI. The proportion of lower SES students attending Blake JPS has decreased in the last decade, shifting the school’s overall demographic profile.

### Individual Variables

The following pages contain the LOI rankings, scores, and the averages of individual variables for each TDSB school (elementary and secondary). To counteract one-time swings that occur in a small number of schools each year, the LOI is calculated using a weighted three-year average of data for each of the variables in the following manner:

- 2020-21: 25%
- 2021-22: 25%
- 2022-23: 50%
