The Toronto District School Board invites applications from qualified teachers to teach in the Secondary Credit International Language program.

International Language Credit courses are offered on Saturdays beginning in October 2026 through May 2027. Teachers are selected based upon subject qualifications related to the delivery of the curriculum and the ability to work with secondary school students on a Saturday in person or a remote school setting. There will be a minimum of 90 program hours. All positions are pending student enrolment and Ministry funding.

The TDSB is committed to the implementation of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada: Calls to Action, and the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, as a guiding principle and a strategic direction

The candidate must also have a demonstrated ability to advance human rights and take actions that address racism in all its forms, while promoting Equity and demonstrating Anti-Oppressive pedagogy.

5. Deadline for applications: **12:00 pm Noon, September 15, 2026.**
6. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Individual applications will not be acknowledged.
