CSIP Application

Primary Program choice and an optional alternate choice

Alternate choice will only be considered after all primary applications for that program from the city of Toronto have been seated.

Applicants seated in their primary choice will not be considered for their alternate

Applicants seated in their alternate choice will remain on the waitlist for their primary choice, unless they request to be removed

Out-of-Area Admission & SSWAB

Applicants may select ONE school for either Regular (English) or French or Remote (VSS)

Applicants may also apply to one SSWAB.

Applicants selecting French must already be currently enrolled in similar programming.
