

International Baccalaureate Diploma Program – Program Fees Frequently Asked Questions

Question: What are the fees for the IB Diploma Program?

Answer: Starting in the 2020-21 school year, there is a fee of \$3000 for the IB Diploma Program (\$1500 in Grade 11 and \$1500 in Grade 12).

Question: When is payment due?

Answer: Below is the fee schedule for the IB Diploma Program. Your school will provide specific instructions for how to pay the fees. For questions or additional information, please contact your school:

- Payment by February of Grade 10 upon course selection for grade 11 - \$1500
- Payment by February of Grade 11 upon course selection for grade 12 - \$1500

Question: Is there a fee for pre-IB?

Answer: There is no fee for pre-IB (Grades 9 and 10).

Question: When are students currently enrolled in pre-IB Grade 10 and IB Grade 11 required to pay?

Answers: Students currently enrolled in pre-IB Grade 10 and IB Grade 11 (in the 2019-20 school year) will be required to pay \$1500 by June 2020 for their fees for the upcoming school year.

Question: Is there any financial assistance available for the IB program?

Answer: Parents/guardians who require financial support to participate in the IB program are encouraged to contact their school Principal.

Question: Why are there fees for the IB program and not other specialized TDSB programs?

Answer: There are costs associated with the IB program that are required by the International Baccalaureate Organization. These costs are related to teacher training, annual dues, program coordination, and participation in IB examinations. Other specialized programs offered at TDSB schools do not have the same required costs.
