Registration Information

There are three easy ways to register: online, telephone, and by mail. In-person registration is temporarily unavailable. Please visit the website for the latest updates. To register by mail please visit the website for the registration form. An account and email address is required to register for a course.

Social Assistance Document and Registration Form Upload

Learners requesting the subsidized rate must submit supporting documentation. Your eligibility must be verified before we can complete your course registration.

Learners can now upload their social assistance documents and registration form directly to their Learn4Life account for review. To assist with this process, please refer to our step-by-step instruction guide on how to upload documents available on the website.

Important: *Do not register online.* Instead, after uploading your documents, you must email Learn4Life to let us know your documents and registration request are ready for review.

Refund Policy

All refunds will be processed according to our refund policy. Please review the policy available on page 4. All refunds are processed back to the original credit card used for payment. Fees paid by cheque or cash will be refunded by cheque after Continuing Education staff acknowledges clearance of the cheque. Allow 4 to 6 weeks. The option to keep funds on the TDSB Learn4Life account is no longer available.

Note: Although the system will accept a pre-paid credit card, to ensure a refund is returned to the user if requested, it is not recommended to use a pre-paid VISA or MasterCard when registering for a course.

Cancelled Courses

A minimum number of registrants is required for a class to run. The Toronto District School Board (TDSB) has the right to make the final decision to open or close a class, or to revise the fee structure. If a course does not meet the enrolment minimum, and is therefore cancelled, every effort will be made to accommodate you in another course. If there is no other course which is satisfactory to you, you will receive a full refund.

Program Accommodation

Community Programs – Learn4Life Refund and Transfer Policy

The Toronto District School Board (TDSB) will process a full refund if the TDSB receives the written request for refund before the course begins.

Refunds are processed back to the original credit card used for payment. Fees paid by cheque or cash will be refunded by cheque after Continuing Education staff acknowledges clearance of the cheque. Allow 4 to 6 weeks. The option to keep funds on the TDSB Learn4Life account is no longer available.

For courses under five weeks in duration:

No refunds or transfer requests will be considered after the class begins.

For courses five weeks or longer:

If you withdraw after the first class, a pro-rated refund (minus a \$15.00 administrative fee per course plus a portion of the material fee if applicable) will be processed if the TDSB receives the request for refund in writing.

No refunds or transfers will be considered once the second class has started.

For subsidized courses: No refunds or transfers will be considered after the class begins. If TDSB cancels the course before it begins, the refund will be issued to the TDSB Learn4Life account.

Summer Refund Policy: No refund or transfer requests will be considered after the class begins.

All requests for a refund or transfer must be made in writing. The effective date of the withdrawal is the date the withdrawal notice is received by the TDSB.
