Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) is how students may obtain credits for prior learning. Prior learning includes the knowledge and skills that students have acquired, in both formal and informal ways, outside secondary school. This information session will outline how students' prior learning is assessed for the purpose of granting credit for a Grade 10, 11, or 12 Ontario curriculum course.
