*The Continuing Education Department invites applications from qualified staff to teach in the Summer Mentorship Program (SMP). This program, offered in partnership with the University of Toronto and other school boards in the GTA, provides eligible TDSB students the opportunity to explore Health Sciences occupations and careers of interest through job shadowing in a university setting.*

*The Summer Mentorship Program was created to disrupt the under-representation of Black and Indigenous people within the Health Sciences. In the SMP, Black and Indigenous high school students or students who have economic barriers are given the opportunity to explore Health Sciences at the University of Toronto. Students successfully completing course requirements will earn the **SNC4M1** credit and will be attached to one of our Remote Summer Programs. The successful teacher will report to the summer administration and follow all summer school timelines for assessment and evaluation.*

*TDSB teachers will be selected based upon experience and subject qualifications, knowledge of and/or lived experience as an Indigenous, Black, or racialized student is an asset.*

*The successful applicant may be asked to attend meetings to discuss program start-up and planning.*

*The TDSB is committed to the implementation of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada: Calls to Action, and the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, as a guiding principle and a strategic direction.*

*The candidates must also have a demonstrated ability to advance human rights and take actions that address racism in all its forms, while promoting Equity and demonstrating Anti-Oppressive pedagogy.*

**Summary of Duties:**

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

- Effectively developing learning and assessment/evaluation materials appropriate for the successful delivery of an online course with diverse learners and potentially in small group, in-class instruction, in accordance with the ongoing guidance of the Ministry of Education;
- Creating and maintaining a learning environment that is respectful and inclusive of all students and responsive to their unique needs;
- Collaborating with student success department head, guidance and administrative staff to maintain a focus on successful outcomes for students;
- Accurately recording student achievement using Mark book or “Grades” and answer to student/parent questions pertaining to their course;
- Attending online staff meetings in accordance with the ongoing guidance of the Ministry of Education;
- Assisting with addressing and resolving all assessment and evaluation related issues; and
- Submitting a complete, detailed Mark book or Grades summary for all students by July 30, 2026.
