The Indigenous Student Summer Leadership Program provides First Nation, Métis and Inuit students leadership opportunities working with Indigenous mentors throughout the month of July.

This is a paid opportunity for First Nation, Métis and Inuit students who are 16 to 20 years of age. Students will:

- Earn 1 co-op credit, with the opportunity to also take part in Credit Recovery.
- Receive additional wrap around support from Indigenous Graduation Coaches.
- Gain invaluable work experience through placements that include: **Nikibii Dawadonna Giiwag, Tungasuvvingat Inuit, The Toronto Zoo, Toronto Transit Commission, Canada's National Ballet School, Art Gallery of Ontario, City of Toronto, Lilliput Hats, etc.**
