Robin Pilkey Elected as TDSB Chair

Robin Pilkey was elected for her sixth term as Chair of the Toronto District School Board during the annual Organizational Board meeting on Monday, Nov. 18, 2019. Trustee Trixie Doyle was elected as Vice Chair.

Labour Negotiations

The Ontario Secondary School Teachers' Federation (OSSTF) teachers and education workers held a one-day walkout on December 4 as a tentative agreement between OSSTF, the Government of Ontario, and the Ontario Public School Board Association was not reached. As a result of the walkout, the Board had no other option but to close all secondary schools (Grades 9 to 12) to students on this date as there would not have been sufficient supervision to ensure student safety. The TDSB remains hopeful that negotiations will continue and that a contract agreement can be reached to avoid any further disruption to students' education.

The Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario (ETFO) began Phase 1 work-to-rule job action on Tuesday, November 26, 2019. The job action is a partial withdrawal of services and is not a full withdrawal/strike at this time. During this phase of work-to-rule, elementary schools will remain open and instructional programs will continue. However, should the work-to-rule progress to include further sanctions, it may have a more significant impact on school activities, permits and school operations. At this time, negotiations between ETFO, OPSBA and the Ontario government continue and we are hopeful that an agreement can be reached soon.

BOARD MEETING NOTES

Implementation of the Parents Reaching Out Grants, 2019-20

The Ministry of Education has announced that the [Parents Reaching Out \(PRO\) Grant](#) will continue. This grant provides funding to district school boards and school authorities to lead projects with a focus on the identification and removal of barriers that prevent parents and families from participating and engaging fully in their children's learning.

Changes to the program were made for the 2019-20 school year from an application-based funding model to an allocation-based grant provided to each school board.

The TDSB was allocated \$133,405.00 for projects.

The Board [decided](#) that:

- The Ministry of Education's Parents Reaching Out Grants allocation amount of \$133,405.00 be distributed, as presented in the report; and
- The Chair sends a letter to the Minister of Education to express the Board's dismay with the changes to the overall funding amount and disbursement process for the 2019-20 Parents Reaching Out Grants.

2020-21 Budget Reductions in Year 2

Trustees [approved](#) the following [recommendations](#) from staff with regards to year two budget reductions approved by the Board in June 2019:

- That French and Gifted bussing reductions in the amount of \$1.9M in 2020-21 be delayed until the Learning Opportunities Index (LOI) review and French redistribution of program sites are completed; and
- That the Director present a report in January 2020 on the achievable savings in 2020-21 and future years on supplementary French and Gifted teachers.

Staff considered the following factors for the recommendations above: Multi-Year Strategic Plan commitments, policy issues, staffing concerns, available resources and timing.

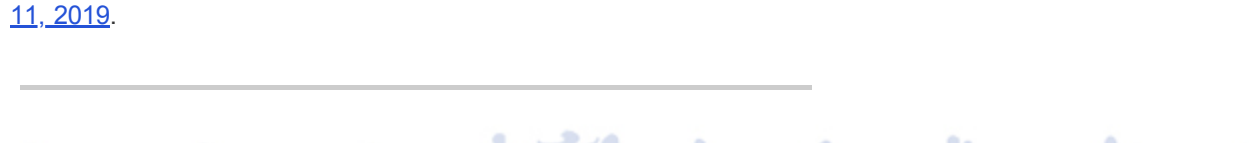
