REPORTING ROAD MAP

Use this roadmap provided on the Study Toronto Website to make sure you have everything you need to report when you arrive.

Before Arrival in Toronto
Complete the online English and Math assessments. After Arrival in Toronto
Complete the reporting procedure with the documents below in-person. Refer to instructions at studytoronto.ca.
Passport photographic page
Most recent transcripts (notarized in English)
Immunization Records (does not need to be notarized or translated into English)
 Notarized IRCC Custodian/Parental forms (required only if the parent(s) will not be accompanying the student during their full study period)
The International Students and Admissions Office will review the documents and send a confirmation email, along with medical insurance documents to the school.
Attend the orientation on 10:00 AM - 13:00 PM (EST), August 26, 2025 at Northview Heights Secondary School : 550 Finch Ave. W., North York, ON M2R 1N6
Contact your day school to register. The first day of school is September 02, 2025.

SCHOOL REGISTRATION

- Once Reporting at ISAO is complete
- ISAO will scan document package to your home school (please allow at least 24 hrs before connecting with your home school)
- Contact the home school GUIDANCE or STUDENT SERVICES department to book a registration appointment with your home guidance counsellor
 - Student Activity Fee upon school registration or soon after





SCHOOL REGISTRATION PROCESS

ISAO will scan and email your documents to your home school:

- Valid Study Permit
- Valid Passport
- Most recent school documents from home country
- Immunization (Vaccine) Record
- International Student Profile Form
- Custodianship Documents Forms 1 & 2 (Notarized)
- Custodian and Homestay: Phone #s and email
- Assessment Results (high school students only)





ATTENDANCE

Students must be in school everyday

- 24 hour voicemail available at all schools (main line)
- Absences <u>verify with a note or call</u> <u>prior to absence</u> and upon the student's return
- Absence = phone call home
- 15 consecutive absences = demitted from school
- Planned absence = send note ahead of time
- Students leaving during the day <u>MUST sign out in the</u> main office with custodian/parental permission





PARENT / CUSTODIAN RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend Registration appointment with student
- Regular and ongoing communication regarding student progress
 - Newsletters, emails, fact sheets, phone calls, letters
- Support student and school
 - Ensure that the student is attending all classes
 - Attend parent-interviews, school presentations, concerts
 - Help student prepare for school (sleep, nutrition)
 - Communicate with parents regularly
 - Escort student to any appointments medical
 - Monitor student's progress, check-ins about homework, tests etc.
 - You may request a meeting with the teacher at any time during the year
 - Make sure that your students renew and make payments on time

Immunization

- must be up to date and complete
- lice, chickenpox must be reported to the School office
- fax immunization records to TPH (does not need to be translated)

In case of Emergency (9-1-1)

- maintain correct address & phone# (custodian / home)
- provide additional emergency contact (name, number, email)
- provide special medical history / medication details

Long Term Illness, Allergies, and Medication

- Refrain from bringing peanut products to school and heavy fragrance
- Inform main office if you carry an EpiPen®
- provide medical documentation (doctor's note) for illness more than 5 days

- Payment of Activity Fees
 - Set up <u>School Cash Online account</u>
- Lockers may be provided in elementary schools, bring your own combination lock

- Contact with custodians and parents is common
