This is Isaiah's third term as an Indigenous Student Trustee, a role that is appointed by the Elders Council.

Student trustees represent the voice of over 250,000 students in the TDSB and sit on the Board of Trustees during Board meetings. The Toronto District School Board is committed to maintaining a learning and working environment that actively promotes and supports Human Rights and accessibility for persons with disabilities. We are committed to actively removing barriers - both visible and invisible to allow all members of our community to fully participate in TDSB activities. How Accessible are TDSB Schools? Out of 570 buildings 160 buildings have been categorized as accessible, 78 as somewhat accessible and 332 as not accessible at all. Far too many are inaccessible to students and staff.
