Dear Students/Parents/Guardians/Staff/Community Members of Eglinton Jr Public School and Spectrum Alternative Sr School:

Re: School Facility Improvements

We are pleased to let you know that the Board approved a Five-Year Capital Building Program that included funding for facility upgrades for the schools that would require program and/or capacity changes as a result of the 2009/10 Accommodation Review process. These improvements will implement the Accommodation Review Committee's final recommendations that were accepted by your Local Design Team.

Let us take this opportunity to publicly thank members of your Local School Community Design Team who provided us with their best advice on your behalf, to ensure our preliminary design concepts supported your school needs.

This letter is to inform you that the **relocation of Spectrum Alternative Senior School** will take place prior to the new school year and that construction for **Eglinton Jr Public School, ARC 9 Phase 2 – Addition and Interior Renovations** will be issued for tender in mid-October. This work consists of building a new full day kindergarten, retrofitting one classroom into a full day kindergarten, minor modifications to switch a ground floor kindergarten and second floor daycare, minor building and facility upgrades including wireless in areas of work. This work will be completed for the start of the 2012 school year.

Work will begin December 1, 2011 and will be completed by September 1, 2012. As with all our school projects, safety measures will be in place to protect students and staff during construction. For work starting before the school year end, access to the construction area will be hoarded and isolated from the school. We will work with your school's Principal Wendy Keene to ensure the work will be coordinated to minimize the impact of construction on school operations. All contractors are aware of the need to schedule any disruptive work including dust and noise after school hours as much as possible.

Residents will be able to contact the Toronto District School Board (TDSB) immediately if any concerns arise during construction. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call Murray Witiuk, TDSB Project Supervisor at 416-395-4138.

We look forward to building the improvements to Eglinton Jr Public School that will enhance our students' Thank you for your support and your patience during this period of change.
